Parents are required to submit a letter explaining the need for scholarship addressed to Ms. Athena Arvanitis, Director of Student Life, stating reasons why the scholarship is necessary. All letters are confidential and treated as such.

Once an application has been approved by Ms. Arvanitis, the student will:

- Receive 50% of scholarship award up front (no more than \$200, via check to family) to be applied towards Speech and Debate Tournament travel.
- Receive remaining 50% (via check to family) after work is complete (see below for details) to be applied towards Speech and Debate Tournament travel.

Student will receive no more than \$400.00 per year, prorated according to when the student began the scholarship.

Student work includes the completion TWO major service tasks each semester. The Speech and Debate Sponsors will work with the student to choose tasks from the list below that best serve the needs of the team and the availability of the student. We will monitor this service closely.

- Complete four to five after school data entry sessions (Total of approximately 10 hours)
- Serve as a student judge at a local tournament for a full day.
- Serve as a runner or assistant at a tournament hosted by New Trier for a full day. (In addition to the regular team expectation.)

Students who do not complete their work/study requirements will not be eligible for future work/study scholarships. Scholarships are funded primarily through donations and may, as a result, be limited.
