

New Trier Township High School Alumni Achievement Awards and Hall of Honor

New Trier Township High School has many distinguished alumni who have used their education and work experiences to make significant contributions to society. Every other year, District 203 honors alumni in the fields of the Arts, Athletics, Business, Communications/Media, Community Service/Philanthropy, Education, and Science/Medicine through its Alumni Achievement Awards, which include recognition in an Alumni Hall of Honor.

Recipients of the New Trier Township High School Alumni Achievement Awards must:

- Be graduates of New Trier who have had outstanding careers, resulting in a direct and significant impact in their fields for a minimum of five years.
- Demonstrate outstanding leadership, character, and service to the community.
- Have school and career records that reflect the values of the New Trier motto: **“To commit minds to inquiry, hearts to compassion, and lives to the service of humanity.”**

Anyone may submit a nomination to the Alumni Achievement Awards Selection Committee. Nominations for the 2017 group of recipients will be accepted until **May 10, 2016**. Nominations may be posthumous.

In addition, this year the District is introducing a new Young Alumnus Award category. Anyone nominated in this category must:

- Be younger than age 40 at the time of the nomination
- Demonstrate potential for leadership in his or her chosen career and in service to the community
- Reflect the values of the New Trier motto

The decision to award an honoree in any category, including the Young Alumnus category, is at the sole discretion of the Alumni Achievement Awards Selection Committee. The committee includes a current student, faculty member, administrators, alumni, and community members.
