

Calculators for Mathematics

New Trier mathematics students will be allowed to use the TI-NSpire CAS iPad app for classroom instruction and activities. In order to maintain test security, however, students may not be allowed to use their personal iPads on assessments.

At the Northfield Campus

- New Trier managed iPads will provide greater security during testing than will be possible at the Winnetka Campus.
- In order to maintain test security, students at the Northfield Campus who bring their own devices in lieu of a New Trier managed iPad may not be allowed to use that device on assessments.
- Students at the Northfield campus will be allowed to use the TI-NSpire CAS handheld calculator in lieu of a New Trier managed iPad.

At the Winnetka Campus

- All mathematics students are expected to have access to the TI-NSpire CAS handheld calculator that they have used in previous mathematics courses.
- Although students can use the iPad app for classroom instruction and activities, teachers may restrict iPad use in assessment situations to insure test security.

AP Mathematics

- Of note for students who anticipate taking Advanced Placement Calculus or Advanced Placement Statistics: The Educational Testing Service and the College Board do not allow the use of iPads on AP exams.
- Students enrolled in AP Calculus or AP Statistics are required to have a handheld TI-NSpire CAS calculator for all assessments requiring technology.
