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## INSTRUCTION

### TRUANT'S ALTERNATIVE AND OPTIONAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS

Supportive services may be offered to a student who is experiencing an attendance problem, including:

1. parent-teacher conferences
2. counseling services by social workers
3. counseling services by psychologists
4. psychological testing
5. alternative educational programs
6. alternative school placement
7. community agency services

The Superintendent is authorized to apply for a grant for the purpose of offering an alternative educational program for truants and to plan and implement such a program.

The student who chooses an alternative education program shall meet with the Principal or designee and appropriate staff for the purpose of developing an individualized optional education plan. The truant student's parents/guardians shall participate in the planning sessions unless the truant student is 18 years or older.
