INSTRUCTION

COMPENSATORY INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES

Compensatory instructional services and activities shall be designed to improve the level of proficiency in identified basic skills of students whose academic, social, or environmental needs prevent them from succeeding in regular school programs and to prevent their regression in such skills when regular programs are not in session.

Equal Education Opportunities

All persons within the District between the ages of 14.5 and 21 shall be afforded the right and opportunity to an equal education. No student shall be excluded, segregated or discriminated against in the District's educational environment for reasons of race, color, national origin, sex, economic status, disability, religion or religious affiliation.
