# **Grouping for Instruction**

Grouping within a school or within a classroom is the responsibility of the Principal, with input provided by the respective staff. The aim of grouping is to place each student in an appropriate and comfortable learning situation.

### **Class Size**

The Superintendent shall work with the Principals and school administration in establishing a reasonable teacher-student ratio in each class.

## **Team Teaching**

Teachers may team teach upon the approval of the Superintendent or designee.

### **Individualized Instruction**

Provision for individual differences shall be given high priority in planning the instructional program, in choosing teaching methods and materials, and in evaluating results.
