ADMINISTERING MEDICINES TO STUDENTS

Parents/guardians have the primary responsibility for the administration of medication to their children.

The administration of medication to students during regular school hours and during school related activities is discouraged unless necessary for the critical health and well being of the student. The administration of medication to students in school is subject to procedures established by the Superintendent or designee.

A copy of this policy shall be given to the parents or guardians of each student within 15 days of the start of the new school term or of the start of a student's enrollment. Students shall also be informed annually of the contents of the policy.
