COMMUNICABLE AND CHRONIC INFECTIOUS DISEASE

The Board of Education recognizes that management and control of communicable and chronic infectious disease is an important goal within the school environment. The Board further recognizes that a student with a communicable and chronic infectious disease is eligible for all rights, privileges and services provided by law and the District's policies. New Trier Township High School District 203 shall permit students with communicable or chronic infectious diseases to continue their attendance at school whenever, through reasonable accommodation and without undue hardship, there is no reasonable risk of transmission of the disease to others.
