C.L. Lindsay is a nationally recognized leader in the field of student rights and academic freedom. As its founder and Executive Director, C.L. has built the Coalition for Student & Academic Rights (CO-STAR) into a national student rights organization that helps thousands of college students with their legal problems, free of charge, each year. He also literally wrote the book on legal problems at colleges. The College Student's Guide to the Law has become the definitive authority used by students, university counsel and as a textbook for masters and law courses nationwide. C.L. has appeared on national television and radio and has been featured in national publications including the Washington Post and Chicago Tribune. He graduated magna cum laude from Denison University, and received his J.D. from the University of Michigan.
