Fri, April 6	Extended deadline for applications The extended application deadline is an option <u>only</u> if space is still available following the recommended deadline.

Application Instructions:

1. You will be able to select Pep Club in PowerSchool; HOWEVER, - selecting the club does not confirm your acceptance - it will appear as PENDING on your schedule until you have successfully completed the application process, and approval has been received from the sponsors. You are responsible for meeting all application requirements and deadlines. Applications are available in the Student Activities Offices on both campuses (Winnetka - W021D / Northfield - C102) and on the Activities page on the school website. Please be sure to have an alternate elective in mind that will serve as your second choice should you not be selected to be a member of the club next year.
2. To indicate your intent to apply, you must submit this completed application by **3:25pm** on February 16. to Ms. Butterly in Rm.300 (Social Studies Office).
NF can turn in applications to your adviser to mail to the Pep Club mailbox at Winnetka
3. Then, to finalize the application process, you must submit your "***Pep Club Board Application Adviser Recommendation***" by March 9. Your adviser should mail this to Pep Club.
4. Initial acceptance letters will be sent out via advisery on March 21.
5. If accepted, Pep Club will then appear on you **DRAFT SCHEDULE.** These will be delivered in advisery at the end of April. However, if your club selection conflicts with another course that you have also selected, you must work directly with your adviser to best resolve that conflict.
