FYI

1. Participation in Student Alliance requires a year-long commitment. We meet every day during 3rd period and it is considered a class. Your attendance will be recorded every day. You **cannot** take it opposite a lab 3 days a week. Also be mindful that you **cannot** be enrolled in the Student Alliance if you are enrolled to take another class that only meets 3rd period (like Symphonic Band, for example).
2. You will be able to select Student Alliance in PowerSchool; HOWEVER, - selecting Student Alliance does not confirm your acceptance - it will appear as PENDING on your schedule until you have successfully completed the application process and interview, and approval has been received from the sponsors. You are responsible for meeting all application requirements and deadlines. Applications are available in the Student Activities Offices on both campuses (Winnetka - W021D / Northfield - C102) and on the Activities page on the school website. Please be sure to have an alternate elective in mind that will serve as your second choice should you not be selected to be a member of the club next year.
3. To indicate your intent to apply for the Student Alliance, you must submit this completed application by February 16.
4. Then, to complete the application process, you must submit your 2 recommendations by March 9.
5. As a final part of the process, you then will need to sign up for an interview with a club officer and sponsor: Interviews will be scheduled sometime between March 12-16: freshmen will meet in the Student Activities Office at Northfield (C102) and sophomores and juniors will meet in the Student Alliance Room (009) during period 3
6. Club acceptance notifications will be sent out via advisery on March 21.
7. If accepted, Student Alliance will then appear on your **DRAFT SCHEDULE**. These will be delivered in advisery at the end of April. However, if your club selection conflicts with another course that you have also selected, you must work directly with your adviser to best resolve that conflict.
