



New Trier Fine Arts Association Student Financial Assistance and Support Guidelines

The New Trier Fine Arts Association is committed to providing financial support to all New Trier students participating in fine arts classes and extra-curricular experiences. Each year the association makes funds available to support student involvement at New Trier. The two opportunities for support and qualifications for each are outlined below.

Financial Assistance is available to students whose families have been approved for district Financial Assistance as determined by the Director of Student Life. Financial assistance is available to qualified families to cover additional costs associated with school-sponsored trips, excursions, or equipment.

Financial Support is available to students whose families are undergoing temporary financial strain or are on a limited budget and who do not qualify for Financial Assistance from the district. Financial Support is available to all families to assist in paying costs associated with school-sponsored trips, excursions, or equipment.
