

***Welcome to individualized
post-high school planning for juniors (Class of 2018)
at New Trier High School***

New Trier's formal post-high school planning process begins in the spring of the junior year; after the initial meeting and spring break, students will meet with their counselor regularly throughout the remainder of the junior and the entire senior year.

Before the initial meeting, each junior must complete a student data form and self-evaluation in adviser room. These forms provide the counselor with background information essential to tailoring the initial meeting to the student's expectations. ***Without the student's forms, scheduled meetings may be canceled on short notice; please make sure your student has completed and submitted this to the adviser in January.***

A copy of each student's fifth-semester transcript is sent home in early March. *Both the student and parent should review every aspect of the document for accuracy.*

Read this first!

Appointments begin at 8:00 AM and run through school day until the last meeting time of 3:30 PM. There are no 3:30 meetings on Fridays.

Initial meetings will begin on Tuesday, February 14, 2017.

Appointments last forty minutes, or one class period. **Students may miss advisery for the meeting, but cannot be excused from any class.**

Parents will be able to call to arrange the first appointment on the day specifically assigned to their particular counselor; for example, parents of students in Mr. Doll's advisery may call January 9. **If you miss your day, please wait until January 20 to call to schedule an appointment.**

The chart which follows indicates when calls can be made for the assigned post-high school counselor.

Because of the volume of calls, voice mail messages left outside of regular school hours (8:00 AM to 3:00 PM) **will not be returned.**

Parents need not do any preparation before the meeting.

- Initial appointments are to be attended by the student and parent(s).
- Appointments are for 40 minutes.
- Students are *never* allowed to miss class for meetings.
