

Concert Wear Fittings – August 2019

As returning music students know, New Trier instrumental and choral students have to make time in August to be fitted for specific concert wear that will be worn during major performances throughout the coming school year.

If you are a boy enrolled in an instrumental or choral program, you need to be fitted for a school-provided tuxedo.

Exceptions: Freshmen Boys' Chorus members, any Jazz Ensemble member, and Music Theory students (your teachers will tell you what to wear for concerts).

It's helpful for boys to come to their fitting with an idea of their jacket and waist size as well as pant length. Note: tuxedos are turned in at the end of each school year.

If you are a girl enrolled in an instrumental or choral program FOR THE FIRST TIME, you need to be fitted for school-provided concert wear (this includes first-timers in Concert Choir or Choir-Opera).

Exceptions: Girls enrolled in Choraliers or High Five who have sung with Freshmen Girls' Chorus or Choraliers before and still have the black velvet dress. The black velvet dress is worn by all 3 groups; thus, you don't need to be fitted.

All students will be fitted in Room W204 at the Winnetka Campus (2nd floor of the Music Dept)
