Vocational Counseling & Support

- Job Seeking Skills: resume and /or portfolio development, applications and interviewing
- Job Trials/Job Shadowing
- Job Maintenance: job coaching, work place advocacy, vocational counseling
- Linkage to Department of Rehabilitation Services and other adult agency services
- Linkages to post secondary training opportunities for career advancement



Academic Support



- Tutorial support for students enrolled in in post secondary educational programs
- Access to assistive technology
- Linkages to Adult education opportunities for improvement of study skills
- Linkages to additional training/educational opportunities

Independent Living Skills Support

- Personal and money management courses
- Assistance with time and schedule management
- Assistance with activities of daily living
- Assistance with accessing community services and businesses
- Linkages to community social and leisure opportunities
