



Class of 2025 Enrollment and Placement Test Information

1) Student Enrollment

New Trier High School will be using an online student enrollment system for the Class of 2025. In November you will receive an email with PowerSchool enrollment information that enables you to make an account and establish demographic, emergency and medical information for your student. New Trier must receive this information in order to confirm your student's enrollment and to ensure that your family will receive future communications. The parent profile form will also be included with the PowerSchool enrollment.

2) Placement Test Information

The New Trier Placement Exam will be administered on the dates below. The placement exam will be administered at the **Winnetka Campus** (you must enter the building on the North side of the building – Trevian Way). *Please see the attached safety precautions for testing during Covid-19. Students will be at New Trier for longer than our previous testing sessions due to safety procedures.*

Test Day Schedule:

Doors Open: 7:45 a.m.

Testing Ends: After 1:00 p.m. (Times will vary)

Supplies Needed: Pencils and Erasers (there are NO calculators allowed on the CTP5 test)
(Students may bring water and a snack for breaks)

Drop Off and Pick Up:

All doors on Winnetka Avenue will be locked, so please plan to drop off and pick up your child at the entrance on Trevian Way. Trevian Way is a one-way access road along the north side of the building. Please see the attached map.

The testing period will begin with a 20-minute writing assessment and self-evaluation. We will then administer the Educational Records Bureau's "Comprehensive Testing Program 5" (CTP5), which consists of five sections: Verbal Reasoning, Reading Comprehension, Quantitative Reasoning, Mathematics Part 1, and Mathematics Part 2. Information concerning ERB and its program may be found at www.erbtest.org. Testing time is 210 minutes.
