DISTRICT ACTIVITY FUND MANAGEMENT

The Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent for Business to create student activity fund accounts to support approved organizations. Such accounts shall be administered in accordance with *The School Code of Illinois*, regulations developed by the Illinois State Board of Education, and sound accounting principles.

The handling of money by faculty members for class needs and student activities shall be kept to a minimum. A fee bill will be prepared for every student each semester which will include the cost of the student activities ticket, the expense of class instructional materials, charges for rentals or purchases of school goods and such other necessary school expenses as have been approved by the Superintendent. Any fee which causes an undue hardship upon the student and his or her family may be ordered remitted by the Principal or designee.
