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INSTRUCTION CURRICULUM CONTENT

New Trier's curriculum is grounded in the District's philosophical mission and designed to meet the District's goals and objectives. The curriculum development process promotes innovation to keep the curriculum relevant and dynamic, while also maintaining adherence to District and academic disciplinary objectives.

The Superintendent or designee will ensure that the curriculum contains instruction on subjects required by State statute or regulation, regularly incorporating changes into the curriculum as required by new or revised state law. Primarily, a student's course of study will stimulate intellectual and social-emotional growth through a curriculum designed by New Trier faculty that includes state-mandated subjects and topics.
