STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS

Recognition of Student Groups

Subject to the Board of Education's review, the administration has the authority to recognize student organizations which acquire school sponsorship by meeting requirements as to organizational structure, place and frequency of meetings and democratic election procedures. If such recognition is granted, the use of the District's facilities and equipment will be allowed.

Students may organize clubs to discuss controversial issues. Critical examination and the balanced presentation of differing views on controversial issues are encouraged.

Student Performing Groups

The Board encourages participation of students in performing groups within the school and before community groups. Participation of students in festivals and contests within the state of Illinois and in performing groups outside the state shall be restricted to situations of exceptional educational value as recommended by the Principal and approved by the Superintendent or designee. Commercial exploitation of student groups shall be avoided.
