Attached to BoardDocs for your review is the summary of the work of the New Trier 2030 Planning Committee and the six Framework Committees. Each Framework Area has a one-page statement of why the area is of importance to New Trier along with a set of core values and goals that will guide our future work. These documents are meant to live for the life of the plan, with the exception of minor modifications that may be needed to reflect new or changing contexts and conditions. Your review and comment on Monday is the last step before we present these one-page statements for approval in January.

On Monday, we will review the development of this plan, which has been a rewarding and challenging experience that involved many staff, students, parents, and other community members as shown in the table below:

On Monday, we will also review the next steps in implementing New Trier 2030. After affirmation of the core values and goals in January, the annual process, integral to this strategic plan, will begin. That process will start by setting priority goals for the 2019-2020 school year and establishing strategies that will be implemented in pursuit of the chosen goals. The Board of Education will approve the prioritization of goals and strategies as part of approving the Superintendent's 2019-2020 goals, which will culminate at the April Board Meeting. In pursuit of presenting a viable 2019-2020 plan to the Board in April, I will be working closely with the staff and leadership teams to map out how the proposed work will impact each area to ensure the totality of the goals and strategies we select will not overwhelm the system or any specific area of the system, yet improve the experience of our students in our great school.
