



NTFAA Private Art Lessons Scholarship Program

The New Trier Fine Arts Association (NTFAA) recognizes the financial challenges that COVID-19 has put upon a number of our fine arts families. Many New Trier Fine Arts students take private lessons that help them participate in their arts classes at school. In these unprecedented times, families may have to prioritize other expenses over private arts lessons.

NTFAA seeks to support the pursuit of the arts during this unusual time. The intent of this scholarship program is to offer funds for students whose families who have faced disruptions caused by the COVID-19 outbreak. We will do our best to support as many students as possible, but funds are limited. If the demand exceeds our available funding, we may need to cap funding.

About the Scholarship

Confidential, one-time scholarships of \$125 per student to help offset the cost of private lessons, whether taken at New Trier or at another location.

Open to current students enrolled in the arts at New Trier (Freshman through Seniors).

The private lessons should relate to a Fine Arts activity that the student is currently engaged in at New Trier.

The scholarship should be used to offset costs of private lessons occurring during the second semester of the 2019-20 school year (including remote, online lessons via videoconferencing) and may be used for lessons paid on an hourly basis or by semester.
