

Dear Junior Parents and Guardians,

The [Illinois School Code](#) and [ISBE Rules](#) require public-school students to take the state's final accountability assessment, currently the SAT without Essay, in order to receive a high school diploma. This is a reminder that all juniors will take the SAT on Tuesday, April 13, 2021. ISBE automatically registers all students for the state SAT and no payment is required.

New Trier testing safety procedures and guidelines are [attached at the bottom of this email](#) and exam day information for students is below.

### **Exam Day Information**

- Arrival time is 7:45 a.m. at the Winnetka Campus
- Enter at the East (Essex Road), North (Trevian Way) or South (Winnetka Avenue) doors
- Students must show their Ruvna QR code for entry
- Testing room assignments will be emailed to students' New Trier email and given to advisers.
- There will not be breakfast or lunch service.
- Students will be dismissed when testing is complete. Anticipated completion times are below.
  - Standard testing 11:45 am
  - 50% Extended Time 1:45 pm
  - 100% Extended Time 12:45 pm
    - 100% Extended time students are required by the state to test April 13th and 14th.
    - The anticipated day 2 completion time for 100% extended time students is 10:15 a.m.

### **Required Exam Day Items**

- Picture ID: School ID, passport, state ID or driver's license
- Several sharpened #2 pencils with erasers
- Calculator - All models are approved

Headphones, cell phones, iPads, and smart watches are prohibited in the testing area. Cell phones must be put away and turned off - the sight or sound of a phone in the test room will result in immediate dismissal.

If your student is absent April 13, 2021, they will have an opportunity to make up the test on Tuesday, April 27, 2021.
