Filmmaker and parent-advocate Dan Habib will talk about what it takes to disable segregation and create a culture of inclusion in our schools and communities.

Dan Habib, the director/producer of *INTELLIGENT LIVES*, is the creator of award-winning documentaries *Including Samuel*, *Who Cares About Kelsey?*, *Mr. Connolly Has ALS*, and many other films. Habib's work has been featured in dozens of film festivals, broadcast internationally, nominated for Emmy awards and translated into 17 languages for worldwide distribution. In 2014, Habib was appointed by President Barack Obama to the President's Committee for People with Intellectual Disabilities, and is currently a filmmaker at the University of New Hampshire's Institute on Disability. Habib and his wife, Betsy, live in Concord, NH, with their sons Isaiah, 22, and Samuel, 19.
